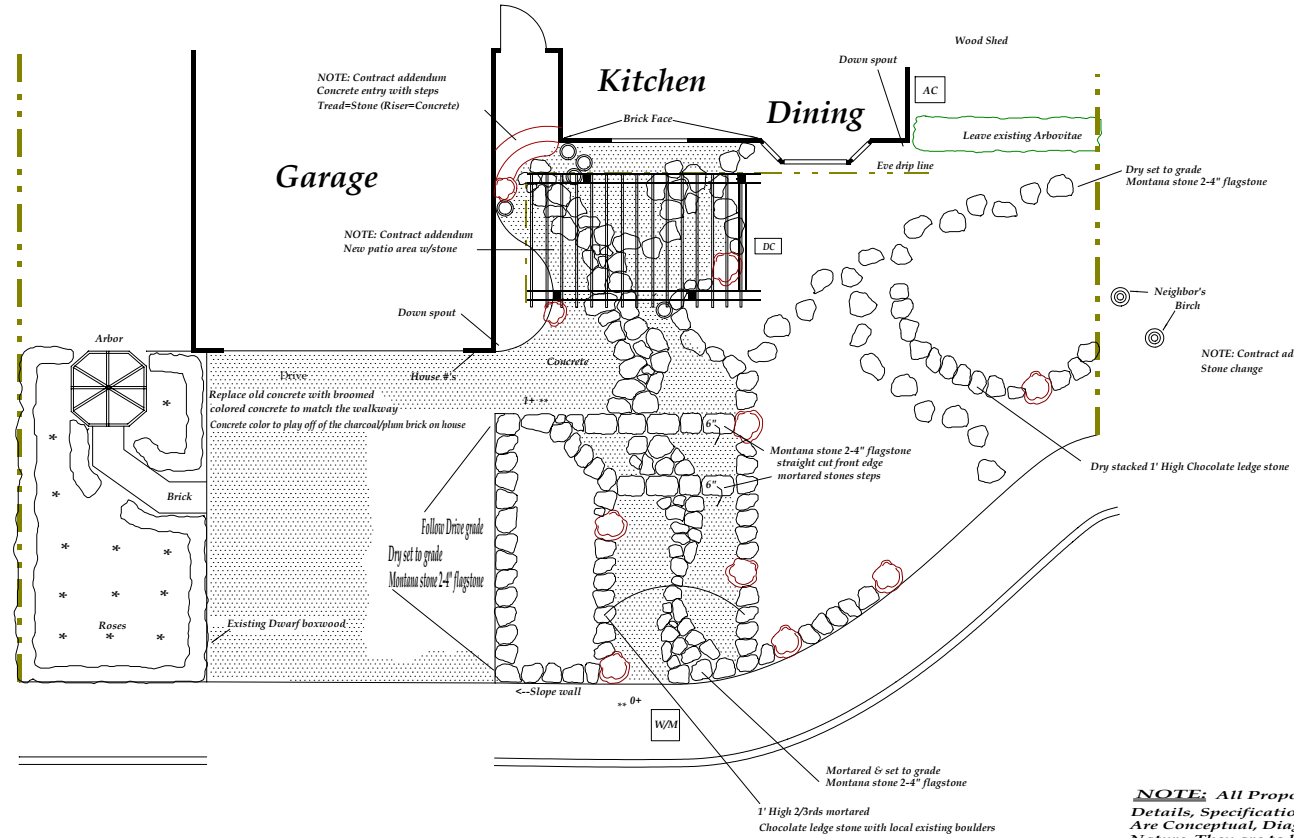


# Garrison/Vanderbilt Residence



- SITE PREP**
- \* Remove existing plants
  - \* Remove existing soil to minus 1.5 ft from existing grade & to fit new grades
  - \* Place water line to house in a sleeve under new concrete & step areas
  - \* Add back 1.5 ft of bulk potting soil mix to grade

- CONCRETE DRIVE WAY & WALK**
- \* Remove existing driveway & entry walk
  - \* Place 4" sleeve under driveway & walk area
  - \* Pour new driveway and walk as shown

- MORTAR STEPS & STONE WALK AS SHOWN**
- \* This should fit the grade of the concrete walk
- MORTAR WALLS & DRY STACK WALL AS SHOWN**
- \* This follow the concept & crafted on site

- SPRINKLER SYSTEM**
- \* Install new system to cover both sides of drive & run wire & pipe to back for future
  - \* Place Clock in the garage


- NIGHTLIGHTING**
- \* Still to be determined

- DECK & STRUCTURE**
- \* Remove existing flower boxes
  - \* Cut in new steps as shown
  - \* Place 5 posts as shown
  - \* Posts are to have curves (see concept)
  - \* Top structure to be curved double 2 x 12's North & South
  - \* Top cross pieces to be 2 x 4's 1ft on center
  - \* All wood to be Cedar

- PLANTING**
- \* See Planting plan (Owner)
